

## **Robert Morden**

Robert Morden was a bookseller, publisher and mapmaker. His premises from 1688 to 1703 were in Cornhill, London, England

His best known maps are those of English counties first published in 1685, and subsequently re-issued in 1722, 1753 and 1772. These maps were nicely engraved with a moderately decorated cartouche and endowed with numerous place names.

The first issue – 1695 – was usually printed with a good impression on rather thin paper; the second – 1722 – had a watermark of a horse encompassed in a circle, and the paper somewhat thicker, the third and fourth were printed on good quality, smoother paper
